

DR. HENRY A. STOUT, OF WENONAH, DIES

WENONAH, Jan. 16.—Dr. Henry A. Stout, one of the best-known physicians in South Jersey, died Sunday night in his 59th year. He was attending his office practice as usual and was about to retire for the night when stricken by heart disease.

He served as Coroner twice, was a member of Borough Council several years and was an official in the State Medical Society. Besides, he held membership in Mantua Lodge of Masons, Cyrene Commandery, Crescent Temple, Mystic Shrine, of Trenton, and Sons of the American Revolution. He is survived by his widow and son, Dr. H. Wilson Stout, of Wenonah, and daughter, Miss Eleanor Stout.
