

KILLED AFTER WEDDING

Mantua Girl In Briday Party Run Down By Automobile

MANTUA, N. J., July 10.—Miss Margaret Carre, aged 23 years, struck by an automobile last evening as she stepped from another car, was run over and received injuries from which she died shortly after. No one is blamed for the accident.

Miss Carre had been attending a wedding and a big party had prepared to accompany the bride and groom in a "send-off" gathering. The party had stopped to make some changes. Miss Carre alighting stepped in front of an auto run by William D. Duffield, a Woodbury caterer, and was knocked down and run over. She was carried to her home, a short distance away, but died within a few moments.

The marriage of Miss Luvene Robinson and Samuel Allen was marred by the untoward event.
