







FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of the design, in which the outer surfaces of a packaging container for paint and painting equipment are smooth and flat;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the design, in which the top surface of the container has a series of parallel ribs thereon;

FIG. 3 is a third embodiment of the design, in which the top surface of the container has a quadrilateral rib thereon;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.

The side not shown is a mirror image of the side shown. The rear and bottom not shown are substantially plain.
